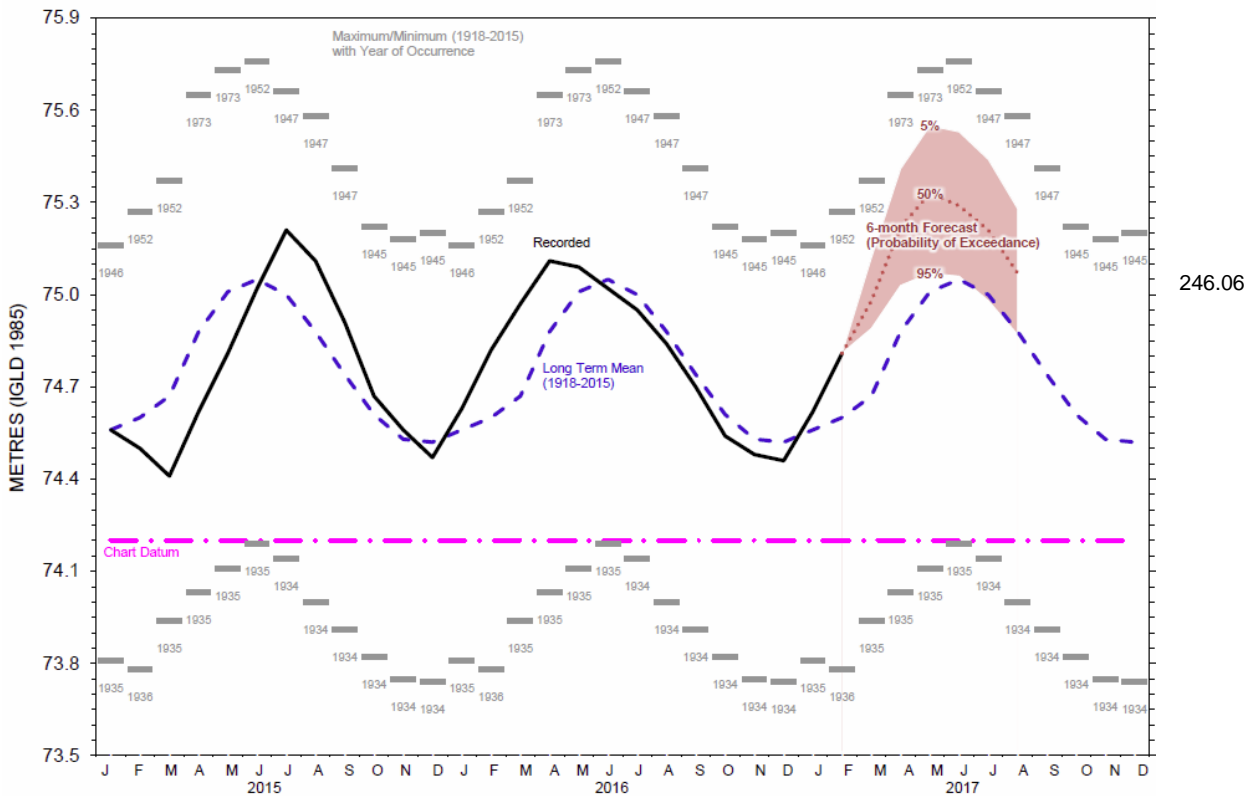

Historical Record:

Flooding /Damage occurred on South shore of Lake Ontario:

March 1973 Water Level = 246.49 ft. = \$87 million in damages

April 1993 Water Level = 246.9 ft. = untold damages

1997 Water Levels did not reach Plan 2014 triggers = \$20 million dollars in damage to Niagara County alone.
